BC Ultimate (BCU) Junior Coaching Eligibility Criteria

Coaches are appointed by their club program, league, or in the case of provincial teams, BCU. To be an eligible BCU junior coach, the following criteria must be met.

Eligibility

- The Head Coach of each team must be 21 years of age or older on December 31st of the year of the event;
- The Assistant Coaches must be 19 years of age or older on December 31st of the year of the event;
- Signed BCUS Coach and Chaperone Policy
- Signed letter by a director of their Club organization or local league indicating that they are an approved coach of that body.
- A vulnerable sector criminal record check indicating that there are no offences or charges that would make the coach unsuitable to work with youth.

Requirements

- NCCP Making Head Way in Sport completed
- Online SOTG & Rules test, minimum score of 80%
- NCCP Making Ethical Decision and online evaluation completed
- NCCP Ultimate Competition Introduction course completed
- Concussion Awareness Training Tool (CATT) Completed
