## 2019 Bursary Application

The following document describes the criteria, deadline and steps necessary to apply for the British Columbia Ultimate Society (BCU) Bursary. The BCU Bursary program was created to provide additional financial assistance to students who best represent the sport of Ultimate, the Spirit of the Game, and who have an interest in contributing to the continued development of the sport.

**APPLICATION DEADLINE: May 15, 2019 at 5:00pm**

**AWARDS ANNOUNCEMENT: May 22, 2019**

**NUMBER OF BURSARIES AVAILABLE: 4**

**VALUE OF BURSARIES: \$750**

The 2019 Bursary Program will award up to four (4) bursaries to students in the province of British Columbia, who will be entering an accredited post-secondary institution in the fall of 2019.

### **Your application must include:**

- A short, one page essay describing how Ultimate has influenced your personal development and future direction; include specific educational goals and financial needs
- The contact information of your current team's coach or teacher sponsor and a letter of reference

- An accepted letter to the post-secondary institution of your choice is preferred. Proof of full-time enrollment will be required prior to bursary being issued (scanned or downloaded copy of documents are acceptable)
- Your current contact information, including date of birth, current grade and school of graduation

**Selections will be made based on:**

- The quality of the essay
- Demonstrated financial need
- Embodiment of Spirit of the Game
- Planned future contributions to Ultimate

At minimum, one bursary will be granted per gender with four (4) total bursaries being made available. The BCU reserves the right to award fewer bursaries if there are insufficient qualified applicants.
